RE: PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY (PWA) RECOMMENDED REPAIR TOP TEN LIST OF SEVERELY DAMAGED CITY-OWNED STAIRWAYS & PATHWAYS

SUMMARY

This report contains the top-ten severely damaged city-owned stairways/pathways cost estimate for repairs, as determined and recommended by the Public Works Agency. The updated survey list of stairways/pathways in the City of Oakland is also included in this report. (*see Attachment B*)

FISCAL IMPACT

Attachment A shows the top-ten list of severely damaged stairways with the highest priority of repair. Using the same existing material, the total cost to replace or repair these structures is estimated at approximately three million dollars. (\$3,000,000.00)

BACKGROUND

On November 28, 2000 the supplemental report and recommendation on the maintenance and cost of repair of city-owned stairways/pathways was presented to the City Council. Staff has been directed to rank the top ten stairways/pathways in order of most urgent need of repairs as shown in the table in *Attachment A*.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Through visual assessment of all the listed city-owned stairways/pathways, staff was able to determine which stairways/pathways have priority of repair.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends acceptance of this informational report.
